The concept of smart factory and connected manufacturing is now a reality. Due to network connectivity and operational technology systems, manufacturers are more prone to threats to their security. Cyberattacks pose a growing threat for manufacturing including sabotage of operations, alteration of data and product designs and theft of intellectual property. The Committee will exchange views on the importance of cybersecurity challenges for manufacturers, the EU Cybersecurity Act and how to address cybersecurity for example with better integration of cybersecurity in existing systems or by creating secure-by-design- manufacturing environments.

The Machinery Directive is one of the main pieces of EU legislation affecting our sector. The Commission is currently carrying out an impact assessment to evaluate a possible revision of the Directive particularly in relation to cybersecurity and new technologies such as AI. In this session we will discuss the input of our sector to the Commission consultation process that will take place in the second half of 2019.

As industry discovers the advantages of additive manufacturing (AM), its adoption grows in Europe. So does, too, the attention of European regulators on the technology. AM, just as other innovations in industry, has peculiarities that distinguish it from conventions. But should these differences justify a different legislative approach than other production technologies? Is the EU focusing on the right priorities and what is CECIMO doing to avoid the EU hitting the brakes on AM growth because of overly-strict regulation? By attending this

meeting, delegates will have an insight into what is precisely happening in Europe on AM policy and regulation and be provided with an informative environment where to discuss critical concerns for the technology's uptake.
